Associate Awards may be executed by Missions and operating units that relate to any of **CAP's four programmatic objectives**:

- Objective 1: Organizational development, operational and/or technical capacity of local NGOs, networks and ISOs strengthened;
- Objective 2: Linkages among local organizations (NGOs, coops, networks, governments and businesses) strengthened;
- Objective 3: Increased capacity of NGOs, networks and ISOs to engage in advocacy for key policies or programs; and
- Objective 4: Wide dissemination of tested innovations, best practices and lessons learned.

New Associate Awards may be executed until **8/11/09**. Associate Awards may run until **8/11/14**.
